Falcon Foodservice Equipment is part of the AFE Group.

Operational on site activities at Falcon are principally concerned with design, administration, fabricating of sheet metal, the assembly and testing of prime cooking catering equipment, general maintenance of facilities, warehousing and distribution.

- The Managing Director has responsibility for the establishment, authorization and issue of policy including review or amendment.
- The Engineering Director has board and operational responsibility for ensuring compliance within the sphere of product design, and responsibility for policy implementation and compliance within the sphere of manufacturing operations.
- The Engineering Director has operational responsibility for policy development, documentation, implementation, compliance and control relative to environmental legislation.

Falcon Are Committed to: Maintaining an effective management system that meets the requirements of ISO14001 by:

- Operating its activities in keeping with all relevant legislation and other requirements including associated statutes, regulations, standards and best practices.
- Establishing environmental objectives and targets with the aim of developing a continual improvement programme

- Promoting supplier awareness of environmental responsibilities within their sphere of operations.
